RULES OF THE SCHOOL

The Mohamed Ebrahim Islamic School is a private school. Parents requesting enrolment are requested to please read the following carefully before filling in the application forms. The right of admission to the school is reserved based on the following:

- Adherence to Islamic ethos of the school
- Prompt payment of school fees
- Behaviour of learner. The school has a demerit system in place for learners who continuously misbehave, are aggressive or who show disrespect to the educators.
- Attendance and progress. Learners who show no interest in schoolwork and who do not complete tasks and assignments, can be issued a transfer card. MEIS expects full attendance from every learner. Should attendance be poor, the learner can be removed from the school
- Parents are requested to pack a healthy lunch for learners.

ROLE OF PARENTS:

Parents are the primary care givers and role models for their children. As such, parents have the responsibility of ensuring that rules of the school are respected. Rules and regulations vary from school to school and the rules established at this school are based according to Islamic principles as laid out in the Quraan and practises of our Beloved Nabi (saw). From the very outset, parents are requested to take heed of the following:

- Parents are requested to adhere to the Islamic dress code at school and during all school functions.
- Separate seating for men and women must be strictly adhered to.
- Islam has accorded a high status to the teacher. Parents are requested to please address teachers with courtesy and respect. Should you have a matter of concern, please direct it to the teacher personally.

COMMITMENT TO THE SCHOOL:

Your child will be attending the MEIS entirely upon your request. You are therefore obliged to exercise loyalty to the school and are advised to please discuss matters of concern directly with the management.

1. I/We shall be liable for school fees as levied by the school shura.
2. If school fees are in arrears, the school is entitled in its sole discretion to exclude my/our child from certain or all school activities, and to retain my child's school report.
3. Should I/we experience financial difficulty and wish to apply for an extension of time or any other relief that may be available, the onus lies on me/us to apply to the school for such exemption and to provide the information required to enable the school to determine the form and quantum of relief/exemption required.
4. I/we agree to pay all costs on the attorney/client scale in the event of proceedings being instituted to recover fees by either an attorney or debt collection agency.
5. I/we acknowledge that school fees are payable within the first two weeks of each school term.
6. I/we understand that the school requires a term's notice of intention to remove my child from the school. Otherwise, I/we become liable for a term's fees in lieu of such notice.
7. I/we are liable for bank charges in the event of dishonoured cheques. Cheques post-dated for after the close of the school term will not be accepted.
